Crime Prevention Tips

Always keep doors and windows locked, even if at home and especially at night.

Make sure to turn on alarm systems, even if at home for added protection.

Make sure garage doors and driveway gates are closed, if not physically in view of them.

Make sure trees and shrubs are kept trimmed & cut, to provide maximum visibility (specific measurements are explained during security survey).

More Crime Prevention Tips

Use a "peep hole" or cameras to check persons at your front door BEFORE engaging them.

Don't engage persons at your front door if you don't expect anyone, can't see id tags, or in a distinct uniform.

Exterior lighting should illuminate the entire exterior of the residence, especially the front portion which faces the street.

Never allow mail or packages to be "stored" at your front door.

Even more Crime Prevention Tips

Don't leave keys in "obvious places" (under door mats, in planters, in mailboxes, in or under furniture, etc.).

Utilize the "vacation house watch" program when away from home more than 24 hours.

Call Southside Police to report suspicious or unusual activity.
